EXAMPLES MAY NOT APPLY!

1. Resource Category: **Resource**
2. Description: ***Beyond the required curriculum, we provide a variety of special programs for our students in art, math, science, writing, debate, theater, media, field trips, student tutors, and adult mentors.***
3. Typical operation: ***Various programs are available throughout the school year, from September through May, normally 8:30 to 5. Programs vary in the start and end times. Check with the Office.***
4. Age-groups: **Grades 6 - 7, ages 11 - 13**
5. List of any fees, restriction, etc.: ***It varies between programs. Check with contact person or School office for any special requirements and enrollment limits.***
6. List any referral or parental permission requirements: ***The child will bring a permission form home to have the parent sign. The child returns the document to the teacher involved. The mentor program requires a teacher referral and signed parental permission. The mentor has a brief meeting with the parent at the beginning and end of semesters, to identify needs, goals, and approaches.***
7. Transportation? ***Yes, the school can normally bus children who participate in various programs before and after school. With signed permission from the parents, the program coordinator or the School office makes arrangements.***
